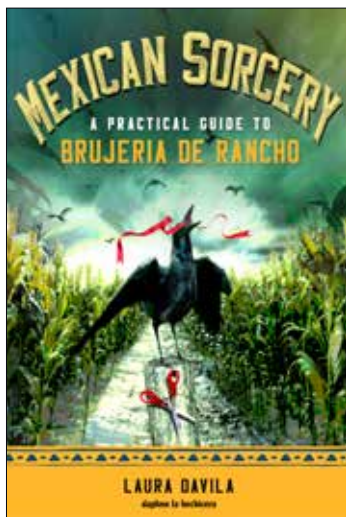
The word "shamanism" is frequently bandied about but rarely used accurately. What is it? Where is it from? How does one become a shaman?

Author David Shi, for whom these are family traditions, explores the history and practice of shamanism. He guides readers through unfamiliar territory—the landscape of North Asia—and through what are largely hidden traditions. He takes an in-depth look at three main cultural shamanic traditions: Turkic, Mongolic, and Tungus.

Spirit Voices features history, first-hand experiential reports, mythology, and folklore to explore the spirits, spirituality, and practices of true shamanism. Shi also provides practical information for those readers seeking to implement practices that are appropriate to non-initiates and outsiders of the culture.

This book showcases the writings of a true "bruja de rancho" or "ranch witch" and features spell work, spiritual cleansing, herbal magic, along with information on how to protect against the Evil Eye, and how to break or avert hexes and curses.

"Brujeria de Rancho," better known as Hechicería or "Mexican Sorcery," was (and still is) a term used to refer to witchcraft as it is practiced in the rural areas of Mexico. There, the Hechiceras offer their healing and divinatory powers, acting as advisors, and even meting out justice through the use of cursing and hexing for people who are often not able to pay lawyers' fees.

Fifth-generation witch, Laura Davila, who learned her practice at her grandmothers' knees, presents Mexican bruja beliefs and practices to today's readers. The tradition includes a component of folk Catholicism that will be accessible to Pagans, non-Catholics, and practitioners of Hoodoo and Conjure.

About the Author Born and raised in Mexico, Laura Davila has lived in the US for since 2010. She identifies as a "bruja de rancho"—a "ranch witch"—a term with great resonance in Mexico indicating knowledge of botanicals and the natural world. 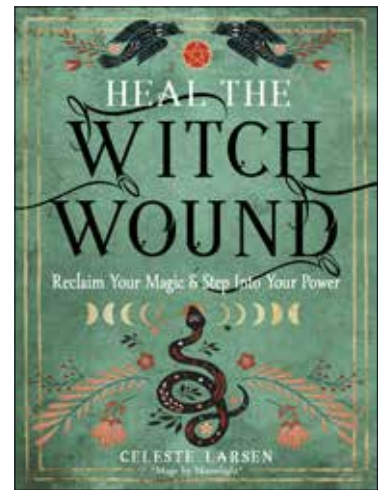
A practical guide for modern witches and healers that includes rituals, journal prompts, visualization exercises, and other tools.

An essential reference on Enochian language as revealed to Dr. John Dee and Edward Kelley in the 16th century, with a new preface by Stephen Skinner that sets the tone and historical context for today's readers.

In 1581, Dr. John Dee, an advisor in the court of Queen Elizabeth I, began a series of experiments intended to contact the spirit world. With Edward Kelley acting as the medium in these experiments, Dee was able to record communications as they were transmitted in Enochian, the language of the angels. Dr. Dee's efforts furthered the development of the Enochian system of magic, and his methods of invocation have been expounded upon by many magicians since.

Donald C. Laycock recounts the history of their experiments and provides a pronunciation guide for the twenty-one letters. The result is a fascinating linguistic and magical mystery story, integral to any study of the Enochian tradition.

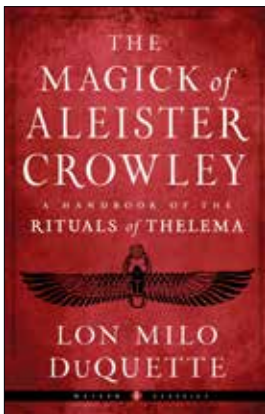
A true classic from the founder of modern-day Wicca—essential reading for anyone wanting to understand the living history of the modern-day revival of witchcraft.

Often called the father of modern witchcraft, Gerald Gardner's works were ground-breaking in opening the door for the modern revival of Wicca and neo-paganism. *The Meaning of Witchcraft* (first published in 1959) was the first sympathetic book written from the point of view of a practicing witch.

"The foundation of magical beliefs," Gardner wrote, "of which witchcraft is a form, is that unseen Powers exist, and that by performing the right sort of ritual, these Powers can be contacted and either forced or persuaded to assist one in some way. People believed this in the Stone Age, and they believe it, consciously or not, today. It is now well known that most superstition is, in fact, broken-down ritual. The meaning of witchcraft is to be found, not in strange religious theories about God and Satan, but in the deepest levels of the human mind, the collective unconscious, and the earliest developments of human society."

This Weiser Classics edition includes a new foreword by Pam Grossman, author of *Waking the Witch*.

About the Author Gerald Brousseau Gardner (1884–1964), was instrumental in bringing the contemporary Pagan religion of Wicca to public attention, writing some of its definitive religious texts. He introduced a string of High Priestesses into the religion, including Doreen Valiente, Patricia Crowther, and Eleanor Bone, from whom the Gardnerian community spread throughout Britain and subsequently into the United States in the late 1950s and early 1960s.

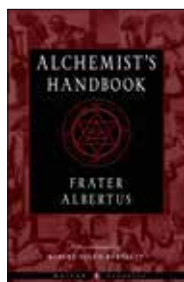

The classic guide to Thelema is the perfect introductory text for readers who wonder what the works—rather than the myth—of Aleister Crowley are all about.

Famed occultist Lon Milo DuQuette begins by dispatching some of the myths that have surrounded Crowley's life and legend. He then explores the practice of rituals themselves, unpacking Crowley's often opaque writing and offering his own commentary. Step by step, and in plain English, he presents a course of study with examples of rituals and explanations of their significance. DuQuette also includes a survey of many of Crowley's original works with an extensive bibliography and endnotes.
